Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters

Chief Whiters reviewed the monthly activity report with the Commission. Chief stated that Officer Walker and Officer Lee started police academy April 3rd and plan to graduate June 23rd

Discussion of purchase of (2) 2023 Dodge Charges from Ginn Motor Company with the assistance of the USDA Community Facilities Grant

The City is receiving \$25,000.00 from USDA grant, \$25,000.00 from General Fund Police Department budget, and \$26,870.00 from SPLOST to purchase the two new police cruisers in the next few weeks.

Discussion of Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) request to Senator Warnock for sewer system repairs and sidewalk improvements.

The City has requested the assistance of Senator Warnock for new sidewalk construction and upgrades to the city sewage system. If Senator Warnock agrees, the projects will be submitted for individual federal funding.

Discussion of search for new City Auditor

Since Stacie Avery is no longer providing auditing services for governments, the city will need to search for a new auditor. Mayor Donaldson will send letters out for bidding. The City Commission will make a final decision in May.

Discussion of Georgia Cities Week in the City of Twin City over April 23-29, 2023

The city cleanup will be on Saturday, April 29, 2023 from 9am to 2pm. Public Works Department will come by and pick up all household garbage items by the road.
