### **Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters**

Chief Whiters reviewed the monthly activity report with the Commission. Chief introduced implementing a curfew for city parks. Mayor Donaldson asked Chief Whiters to examine what other surrounding communities are doing.

## **Discussion of City of Twin City Municipal Court Policies**

Mayor Donaldson reviewed (9) policies recommended for approval by Municipal Court Clerk Jessica Sumner. The policies have been reviewed and approved by City Attorney George Rountree and City Solicitor Sam DeRocco.

#### Discussion of Oak Street drainage issues and repairs

The quote provided to the Commission would solve the continued drainage issues on Oak Street.

## Discussion of purchase of Public Works Department truck

The Commission agreed to authorize Mayor Donaldson for a budget up to \$20,000.00.

# Discussion of Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) request to Senator Warnock for sewer system repairs and sidewalk improvements.

The City has requested the assistance of Senator Warnock for new sidewalk construction and upgrades to the city sewage system. If Senator Warnock agrees, the projects will be submitted for individual federal funding.

## Discussion of search for new City Auditor

Since Stacie Avery is no longer providing auditing services for governments, the city will need to search for a new auditor.

# Discussion of rezoning request for T04 001C at 2735 Hwy 80 E, Twin City from Heather Donaldson

City Clerk Eugenia Ducker attended the Planning Commission meeting on this request. City Clerk Ducker advised the Planning Commission voted to deny the request. The Commission opened a public hearing on the rezoning request. Heather Donaldson addressed the Commission on her request, and the need for more residential housing in Twin City. Gary Grubbs spoke against the rezoning request.
