Presentation from Police Chief Kevin Jarriel

Mayor and Commissioners reviewed the monthly activity report.

Discussion of Georgia Power Government Pole Attachment License Agreement, Addendum for Attachment of Baners and Seasonal Decorations, and Wireless Facilities Addendum.

Mayor and Commissioners reviewed the agreements with GA Power to display the City Christmas décor on the light poles owned by GA Power.

Discussion of quotes for GEMA Generator Grant for Twin City Fire Station

Mayor Donaldson reviewed the (2) quotes submitted for the project: Moore Electrical Co, Inc. for \$19,612.00 and Proctor Electric Services for \$14,700.00. The Commission will move forward with the low bidder.

Discussion of Southeast Cresent Regional Commission (SCRC) Grant application to improve Pop Boogie Recreational Complex

Mayor Donaldson discussed the grant application with the City Commission. The city has applied for this grant before but was unsuccessful.

Discussion of cancellation of July 2025 Regular Meeting due to Independence Day holiday

The Mayor and Commission agreed to cancel the July 2025 meeting.

Discussion of project update from Service Line Inventory

Mayor Donaldson updated the Commission on the progress of the service line inventory. The previously approved contractor is working in Twin City as of the date of the meeting.

Discussion of the compensation of the City Commission

The compensation for the City Commission has not been changed in over 14 years. The Commission reviewed salary data from the DCA on other municipal officials in Georgia from similarly-sized cities. The Commission ran the required public notice in the legal organ for (3) consecutive weeks, which was done in May. This increase will take effect January 2026. The Commission agreed to the following: Mayor will receive \$500.00, Mayor Pro Tem \$300.00, and City Commissioners \$250.00.

Discussion of vacancy on the Planning Commission of the City of Twin City

Due to death of Planning Commissioner Dewayne Rollins, there is a vacancy on the Planning Commission. Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission for suggestions on the replacement.
