CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Donaldson 6:30 P.M.

Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whitters

Chief Whitters reviewed the monthly activity report with the Commission.

Discussion of 2024 GDOT Local Road Assistance (LRA) Grant in the amount of \$42,629.63 and 2024 Resurfacing Planning

This is a one-time GDOT grant with no match required by the City. Commissioner William R Brown III and Mayor Donaldson recommended Rountree Avenue, Commissioner Moody recommended North Railroad Street, Commissioner Brown recommended Ward Street, and Mayor Pro Tem Bady Jr recommended Lee Street. Mayor Donaldson will coordinate with City Engineer McClellan to obtain cost estimates, which will be discussed at the June 2024 meeting.

Discussion of Resolution 2024-04 to declare Municipal Clerks Week – May 5-11, 2024

Mayor Donaldson proposed declaring May 5-11, 2024, as Municipal Clerks Week, in conjunction with International Institute of Municipal Clerks.

Discussion of Resolution 2024-05- Law Enforcement Risk Specialist and Safety Policy Statement

The City is seeking grant opportunities for the Police Department, which require this position to be created. This will be added to the duties of Municipal Court & Police Clerk Jessica Sumner.

Discussions of USDA Special Evaluation Assistance for Rural Communities and Households (SEARCH) Grant for sewer system rehabilitation

Mayor Donaldson briefed the City Commission on this potential grant opportunity. If awarded, this grant will assist the city with the costs associated with an engineering study for the continuing issues with the city sewage system.

Discussion of parking in Downtown Graymont

Mayor Donaldson has received a request to install parallel parking in “Graymont” Downtown area. Donaldson has coordinated with GDOT, and the city will proceed with the project.

Discussion of late chargers on city utility accounts from USPS delays

The City Commission authorized City Clerk Ducker to approve the one-time waiver of any late fees associated with USPS delays. The utility customer will only qualify for one waiver, and the customer must not have been late on any payments in 2024.
