

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Donaldson 6:30 P.M.

Presentation of Resolution 2024-01 for the adoption of West Broad Street to Spring Foundation Lodge 414 members

The Mayor and Commissioners presented members of the lodge with a signed resolution from the city. The City Commission thanked the lodge members in attendance for their volunteerism.

Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters

Chief Whiters reviewed the monthly activity report with the Commission.

Presentation from Fire Chief Foster Grimes

Chief Grimes reviewed several grant opportunities for fire department staffing through FEMA. The Commission agreed to move forward with the grant proposals as presented.

Discussion of fencing quotes from Central Fence for King Street & Apple Avenue lift stations

Mayor and Commissioners viewed quotes provided. This will be a SPLOST expenditure.

Discussion of request for bids for City Reserve

City Clerk Eugenia Ducker mailed letters in March to Durden Banking Company, Citizens Bank of Swainsboro, and Queensborough National Bank & Trust to request bids to be submitted. Ducker presented the only bid submitted from H. Wade Johnson, CEO of Durden Banking Company, Inc at 4.375% for one year. There were no other bids submitted. Due to the conflict of interest, Mayor Donaldson will not be voting on the action item.

Discussion of 2024 GDOT Local Road Assistance (LRA) Grant in amount of \$42,629.63

This is a one-time grant offer with no match required. Applications are due by June 15, 2024. Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission to come to the May 2024 meeting with their recommendations of the roads to be considered.

Discussion of Georgia Cities Week (April 21-27, 2024) and City Clean Up (Saturday, April 27, 2024)

The city will have its annual cleanup day that Saturday, April 27, 2024. No tires will be allowed.

Discussions of GEFA Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant

Mayor Donaldson did not apply for this grant, due to the additional funding needed from the city to complete the project.
