Dear Friends of Historic Twin City, GA, Inc:

As we celebrate the successes of 2017, we are truly happy about the myriad of events that the community had an opportunity to participate in. As we begin this new year, we are very enthusiastic about the upcoming fourth anniversary of Historic Twin City, GA, Inc. We ask that you join our effort as we kick off our annual fund-raising campaign.

This past year, HTCGA used donated funds to host the "Spring Thing Festival," which featured city-wide clean up and fun activities for families, and a "Fifth Quarter" event after a home football game. This event featured live music, vendors and delicious food. A Farmers Market of locally grown vegetables was available for purchase. We also served as a BRAG (Bicycle Ride Across Georgia) rest stop. Finally, our annual Christmas parade planned by our volunteer fire department ended our 2017 events. Funds were also earmarked to help in the restoration of Rountree Park where several diseased trees threatening damage to the cabin were cut. We also commissioned a professional designer for the park through the DCA. A storage building and canopies were purchased for the Welcome Center as well.

Anticipated purchases for the year 2018 include the installation of a gallery track system to display art work, repairing the roof and ceiling of the Welcome Center, installing shelves in storage building, adding road signs directing traffic to Historic Twin City, and creating welcome baskets for new Twin City residents. We will continue the project of developing Rountree Cabin Park. We want you to be a part of all these wonderful events by making a financial donation of any amount.

For several months the city has been in transition. As the new Main Street Manager, I am increasing my knowledge of Historic Twin City, and I am excited about the future of the city. Activities planned for 2018 include continuous city Clean-up, Main Street Yard Sale to kick off the monthly yard sales; Spring Thing Festival; Yard of the Month; Dinner Under the Stars; Concert: Jazz, Country, and/or Gospel performance; Trunk-A-Treat; Christmas Parade; Tour of Homes; and Christmas Gala; etc. As we embark upon this journey, some of which is uncharted territory, we definitely need your support.
